## Conditional Letter of Acceptance – Erasmus+ Traineeship 2019-2020

As Erasmus+ Exchange Programme representative for the Oulu University of Applied Sciences (Oamk, SF OULU11), I hereby declare that we are able to conditionally accept up to three (3) students from the University of Turin, Bachelor Degree Course for Radiographers (CdL in Tecniche di Radiologia Medica per Immagini e Radioterapia), for Erasmus+ Traineeship Exchange Programme in the following hospital/university structure:

- Oulu University Hospital or other relevant third-party traineeship provider(s) with expertise in radiography and radiation therapy (= supervisor role according to Erasmus+ traineeship regulations, see below) via
- Oulu University of Applied Sciences, Department of Special Fields in Health Care (= mentor role according to Erasmus+ traineeship regulations, see below)

Each student's period will be offered in **spring 2020** for the time of **28 February until 30 April 2020** (2 months).

Admission to Oamk and Oulu University Hospital or other relevant third-party traineeship provider(s) is conditional at this stage. Students from the University of Turin should be nominated to [incoming.students@oamk.fi](mailto:incoming.students@oamk.fi) and then apply online via MoveON to Oamk as exchange students respectively trainees within the deadlines, for spring 2020 from 15 until 30 September 2019, if possible, even **by 20 September**.

The exchange should be planned to coincide with the official start of Oamk's regular or short terms, that is, on 28 February in spring 2020, arrival on 27 February. In this case, the trainees will be able to commence their stay with an orientation day and may get the best guidance in administrative as well as academic/professional matters. Students must also include supportive courses, as this will benefit the trainees to better adapt to the living and work environment.

The Erasmus+ traineeship shall consist of the following courses (mandatory):

**O4323ST-3011 Advanced Practical Training, 10 ECTS cr** (traineeship course, 28.2. – 30.4.)

**Y00022E-3028 Finnish Survival Course (Group F), 3 ECTS cr** (evening course, 9.3. - 20.4.)

**OS00CG02-3002 Patient Safety for Future Healthcare Professionals, 5 ECTS cr** (online course, 28.2. -)
